



# NO PRIVATISATION AT NATIONAL GALLERY APPEAL FOR SUPPORT



The National Gallery has told two thirds of its staff they are to be privatised and transferred to a private company. We are responsible for the security of the paintings and the public, provide information about the collection, organise school bookings and look after the millions of visitors each year.

Over 45000 have supported our campaign against the privatisation threat which threatens our pay and conditions as well as the service we provide.

## Reinstate Candy Udwin

Candy Udwin, a senior PCS rep was suspended the day before PCS strike action began and has now been summarily dismissed by the Gallery for asking questions about the cost of privatisation. An Employment Tribunal has already ruled it is likely she was dismissed unfairly for trade union activities.

PCS members will have already taken over 50 days of strike action against the privatisation and to demand Candy's reinstatement. We have been overwhelmed by the support and solidarity we have been shown with protests round the country and thousands of pounds donated to our strike fund.
