

## Sunday 4 October 2015, Manchester

On Sunday 4 October, the Conservative party will open their annual conference in Manchester. The TUC has called a national rally and march in Manchester to coincide with the Tory Party conference.

The assembly point will be Oxford Road from All Saints park southwards at noon with an opening rally at 1pm followed by a march through the city on a route that circles the Conference centre, ending at Deansgate/Whitworth Street for coach pick-ups and dispersal.

The theme of this year's

demonstration is "No to austerity, yes to workers' rights."
