

Help build a stronger union

There are plenty of opportunities for playing an active part in the ARMs network.

ARMs members will be kept updated about relevant campaigns and can participate through a range of activities including signing petitions, lobbying their MPs, attending protests and much more.

ARMs have a number of regional committees made up of elected reps who meet regularly to progress ARMs issues. These are open meetings and ARMs members are welcome to come as observers. There is also an elected national committee that ensures the voice of ARMs members is heard throughout the union.

ARMs reps can also support local PCS branches by mentoring new reps, giving advice on personal cases and supporting their campaigns.

The Direct Debit guarantee

This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits. If there are any changes to the amount, or frequency of your Direct Debit PCS will notify you at least 14 working days in advance to your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request PCS to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request.

If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit by PCS or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society. If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when PCS asks you to. You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
