## **2018 United Nations Anti-Racism Day – Stand Up To Racism demonstrations – 17<sup>th</sup> March - London, Cardiff and Glasgow**

Dear Colleague

To coincide with the **United Nations International Anti-Racism day Stand up to Racism** are organising events to take place on 17 March 2018 in London, Cardiff and Glasgow.

In January the NEC agreed that PCS would add their support to these events and are keen to build for a good mobilisation of PCS members at all three events on the day.

We are now just under a month away from the mobilisations. The **London** event is a national demonstration and rally being promoted under the heading of *March against racism*.

In Scotland and Wales there will be a march and rally in both **Glasgow** and **Cardiff**.

Regional and local rallies with high profile speakers are ongoing to help build for the largest possible attendance at all three events on March 17<sup>th</sup>.

The previous four annual mobilisations were the largest anti-racist demonstrations in two decades and PCS played a major role in the organisation of these events.

The rise in hate crime and vitriolic attacks on migrants and refugees since the EU referendum means it is even more important this year for these, annual anti-racist mobilisations to be large, loud and noticed. PCS wants our members to

take to the streets in numbers to show we stand in solidarity with refugees and migrants and against racism, fascism, islamophobia and anti-semitism.

### **Branch PCS banners**

Branches are encouraged to bring branch banners. PCS placards, and flags will be available from the meet up point at all three demonstrations on the day. **The London PCS contingent will be led by the union's samba band.**

### **Stewards**

PCS will be providing stewards to assist with the running of all three demonstrations and to assist with the distribution of PCS specific materials on the day. Branches and Regions are asked to encourage members to act as stewards wherever possible.
